CONTESTANTS

Nearly 550 professional cowboys and cowgirls from across the United States and Canada will travel to Mandan to compete for more than \$100,000.

CONTEST EVENTS

Each performance features bareback bronc riding, steer wrestling, saddle bronc riding, team roping, cowgirls barrel racing, tie-down roping and bull riding. Plus boys and girls ages six and under ride sheep in the mutton busting.

SANCTIONED

By the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) which sanctions more than 600 rodeos across the U.S. & Canada for world championship points annually. The Mandan rodeo is part of the PRCA Badlands Circuit. The women's barrel racing is sanctioned by the Women's Professional Rodeo Association (WPRA.)

LIVESTOCK

Dakota Rodeo Co., co-owned by Chad Berger of Mandan, brings proven bucking horses and bulls to challenge the cowboys in bareback, saddle bronc and bull riding. Bubel Cattle Co. brings the steers and calves for steer wrestling and roping.

SPECIAL FEATURES

Each rodeo performance features heart-stopping chuck wagon races, plus the comedy antics of rodeo clown Matt Tarr, the Miss Rodeo Mandan queen and princess pageant and a kids' stick horse race July 2 and 3.

CITYWIDE CELEBRATION

From its beginnings on July 4, 1879, Mandan Rodeo Days has grown into a three-day, city-wide celebration which attracts more than 20,000 people each year. Ancillary events for the whole family include the Art in the Park Festival July 3-4, week-long carnival, huge Independence Day parade, a road race and gigantic fireworks display following the rodeo on July 4.
